Lovestreet is composed of former Bryanites John Mauk (guitar/vocals), Chuck Mauk (percussion) and Kevin Maynard (bass guitar/vocals), and Kevin Maiberger (keyboards/vocals) of Tiffin, Ohio.

The band was created in 1987, although the Mauks and Maynard can trace their working relationship to 1983 with the popular Bryan band "Town Crier."

Lovestreet specializes in pop-rock by artists including Led Zeppelin, Bon Jovi, Foreigner, Def Leppard, The Beatles and INXS, as well as writing and recording their own original songs.

In 1988, the group released its debut single, One Side Affair/Take It Or Leave It to positive reviews. The single received considerable airplay on Ohio and Michigan radio stations, charting in some stations' Top 30 hits. Several thousand copies of the single were sold without any third-party promotional assistance.

In 1989, Lovestreet released its One Night album featuring seven original songs. The album's musical spectrum ranged from the haunting urgency of its title track to the rock and roll danceability of a remixed "Take It or Leave It," to the mystery of the collection's closing track "The Explanation."

Lovestreet regularly performed at outdoor festivals including Rally by the River in Toledo, Sandusky's Rock on the Dock, Cleveland's Square to Square festival, Cedar Point, Bowling Green State University, Kent State University and community celebrations and fairs. The group also served as the opening act for popular 1980s bands The Romantics and Henry Lee Summer in Toledo.

Although Lovestreet's original members went their separate ways in 1990, they have all continued to write, record and perform live music. They look forward to reuniting where it all began in the Fountain City at the 2025 Flair on the Square event.
